**General Rules and Regulations**

1. All entries, including perishables, must be brought to the field crop display area at the NPF fairgrounds on Wednesday, November 2, 2011 between 4:00 P.M. and 6:00 P.M.
2. Persons needing help to deliver entries to the fairgrounds should call a chairman in advance.
3. The official placing of field crop entries will be posted by 5:00 P.M. on Friday, November 4, 2011.
4. Premiums will be issued on Sunday, November 13, 2011 between 10:00 AM and 2:00 PM. All field crop entries not removed during this period will become the property of the National Peanut Festival and Fair.
5. No admission tickets or passes will be issued for field crop exhibitors.
6. Established class with less than 3 entries will receive premiums at the discretion of the judges. Entries in an unlisted class with less than 3 entries will receive a maximum premium of \$3.00.
7. Plaques are awarded to Class 01 (peanuts) and Class 05 (cotton) winners. Pictures of these winners and class sponsors are required.

**CLASS 01 – PEANUTS**

Best Arrangement (quality and quantity). The arrangement should be in a bouquet with vines tied and tap roots clipped to better exhibit the peanuts. The arrangement should consist of peanut plants harvested from 3 – 4 foot length of a single row.
