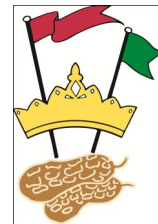

## **CLASS RULES AND REGULATIONS**

**CLASS 01: Professional**—Any person receiving income from photographs.

1. Minimum size 8x10, maximum 12x18.
2. Must be mounted on art board or foam coreboard. No frames accepted.
3. Matted photos accepted, borders not to exceed 3 1/2" on each side.
4. Limit two (2) entries per category per person.

**CLASS 02: Amateur**—Hobby only.

1. Minimum size 5x7, maximum 8x12.
2. Must be mounted on art board or foam coreboard. No frames accepted.
3. Matted photos accepted, borders not to exceed 3 1/2" on each side.
4. Limit two (2) entries per category per person.

**CLASS 03: Open**—Rules are the same as in Classes 01 and 02.

1. Minimum size 8x10, maximum 12x18.
2. Both amateurs and professionals may enter this division.
3. Must be mounted on art board or foam coreboard. No frames accepted.
4. Matted photos accepted, borders not to exceed 3 1/2" on each side.
5. Limit two (2) entries per category per person.

**CLASS 04: Black & White Open**—Rules are the same as in Classes 01, 02 and 03.

1. Minimum size 8x10, maximum 12x18.
2. Both amateurs and professionals may enter this division.
3. Must be mounted on art board or core foamboard. No frames accepted.
4. Matted photos accepted, borders not to exceed 3 1/2" on each side.
5. Limit two (2) entries per category per person.

**CLASS 05: Youth**

1. Minimum size 5x7, maximum 8x10.
2. Must be mounted on art board or foam core board. No frames accepted.
3. Matted photos accepted, borders not to exceed 3 1/2" on each side.
4. Age not to exceed 15 years.

## GENERAL RULES AND INFORMATION

1. Entry fee is \$3.00 per photograph. There is a limit of 15 photographs per person per year.
2. Photographs entered in previous years will not be accepted.
3. We reserve the right to eliminate sensitive subject matter.
4. All reasonable caution in handling & safeguarding of photographs will be exercised. However, the National Peanut Festival assumes no responsibility for any lost or damaged photographs.

6. First, Second, Third & Honorable Mention ribbons will be awarded for each LOT. No money is awarded for winners in each LOT. First Place winners from each LOT will compete for Overall CLASS awards. **ONLY OVERALL CLASS WINNERS RECEIVE CASH AWARDS.**
7. The Chairman reserves the right to reject or reclassify any entries.
8. Entries will be on display in the Premium Building from November 4th through November 12th.
9. Entries should be picked up on Sunday, November 13th between 10:00 AM and 2:00 PM.  
**ALL PHOTOGRAPHS NOT PICKED UP WILL BE HELD AT PHOTORAMA, INC. FOR 30 DAY ONLY.**
10. Photographs with titles, numbers or signatures will not be judged.
11. Checks to the Overall Class Winners will be available for pick up on Sunday, November 13th when you pick up your entry. Any checks not picked up that day will be mailed from the Festival office.

### PRIZES:

ONLY First Place Blue Ribbon winners will compete for cash awards. One First Place Blue Ribbon winner will come from each LOT in every CLASS. The First Place Blue Ribbon winners will then compete for Overall 1st Place, 2nd Place, 3rd Place & Honorable Mention in each class (these are the only placings with cash awards). Cash awards for Overall Class Winners are as follows:

#### CLASS 01: Professional

1st—Rosette & \$100.00, 2nd—\$75.00, 3rd—\$50.00, and Honorable Mention—\$25.00

#### CLASS 02: Amateur

1st—Rosette & 100.00, 2nd—\$75.00, 3rd—\$50.00, and Honorable Mention—\$25.00

#### \*CLASS 03: Open

1st—Rosette \$100.00, 2nd—\$75.00, 3rd—\$50.00, and Honorable Mention—\$25.00

#### \*\*Class 04: Black & White Open

1st—Rosette & \$100.00, 2nd—\$75.00, 3rd—\$50.00, and Honorable Mention—\$25.00

#### CLASS 05: Juvenile

1st—\$75.00, 2nd—\$50.00, 3rd—\$25.00, and Honorable Mention—\$10.00

The Grand Prize Winner will be judged and chosen from the four First Place Overall winners from each Class (excluding Class 05), and will be awarded an additional \$100.00 cash prize and rosette.

The First Place winner of the Peanuts category will receive an additional \$100.00 cash prize.
